DAY 1: 6/3/2015

AFTERNOON

- Reception of participants and welcome evening

DAY 2: 7/3/2015

MORNING

- Analysis of the situation
 - History and conditions of the garden
 - Determine soil
- Discussion about the work plan and elaborate the final design of our garden.
- Start the creation of the garden: remove weeds and unwanted plants.

AFTERNOON

- Presentation: Solidarity and ecological garden: Principles and Philosophy
- Evaluation of the day, input of ideas...

DAY 3: 8/3/2015

MORNING

- Further work: oxygenation and earth movement. Delimitation of planting beds
- Incorporate the soil from the corridors to the beds. (Involving a group of students from one school of the area).

AFTERNOON

- Presentation and debate about these topics : The importance of the soil, ecological agriculture/permaculture, Genetically Modified Organisms (GMO), native seeds preservation (biodiversity)
- Evaluation of the day

DAY 4: 9/3/2015

MORNING

- Finish the preparation of the beds.
- Add the manure and mix it with the ground
- Irrigation system

- Sowing
- construction of an “aromatic spiral”
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AFTERNOON

- Start the creation of the magazine of this initiative
- Evaluation of the day

DAY 5: 10/03/2015

MORNING

- Put the plants / Add the straw ((Involving a group of young people with few opportunities from the area in this workshop).

AFTERNOON

- Magazine workshop
- Evaluation of the day

DAY 6: 11/03/2015

MORNING

- Workshop: Creating a compost

AFTERNOON

- Finalizing the magazine
- Developing the plan of maintenance and operation of the garden
- Final Evaluation
